With Smartform, you can now perform local and overseas remittances by completing the application in the comfort of your office or home before submitting to any HSBC branch.

The Smartform is the way to go if you:

- · Regularly perform domestic and cross border payments and if you prefer to use physical remittance application forms (as compared to on-line submission)
- Want to minimise mistakes and make the application form more legible by typing in the details and using the drop-down menus to fill up the form
- Want to save time and avoid having to re-fill identical details in the form for similar future transactions

- · Save Effort with built-in logic and drop-down menus, as well as saveable payment templates for similar future transactions
- Minimise Errors and Maximise Efficiency in your payment instructions with validation and auto-generated payment amount which will be
- · Better security with an auto-generated barcode, ensuring no further amendments can be made after printing and validation

- · Complete the form on your computer using Adobe Reader, which is available as a freeware at www.adobe.com
- · Print the form by clicking on the 'Print & Validate Form' button, which automatically generates a barcode on your printed form
- Check the details on the form, sign and submit to any of our branches
